



Cost of Attendance Estimates for 2021-2022

The estimated costs below are for Academic Year 2021-22. Please note that the Board of Regents approved a 3% tuition increase beginning in the fall of 2021, but CU Denver will cover the cost of this increase for students during fall semester 2021 and spring and summer semesters 2022 only. The rates below reflect the cost to students after the 3% tuition buy down.

Tuition and fees may increase in the 2022-2023 academic year and beyond and are otherwise subject to change without notice. These rates may not reflect all costs for every degree program. The costs are estimates and can vary based on the pace of each student through their degree program, advanced standing status, etc.
