Credit for Architectural Studios is given on a case-by-case basis. A review of a student's transcripts, portfolio and studio projects help the admission committee determine which NAAB Criteria have been met and which studios a student transfers out of. A student may receive credit for up to two Architectural Studios. The remaining four Studios must be taken here at CU Denver.

Maximum number of transfer credits allowed 45 credit hours

Please note that you must have received a B- or better in the Undergraduate course for it to be considered. Courses with a C+ or lower, and Pass/fail courses, will not be counted for advanced standing. Advanced standing from Undergraduate coursework will not be awarded for elective credit. If Graduate level coursework has been completed, those credits may be reviewed as transfer credit towards degree requirements, including electives. If you feel that you have taken a course that has not been counted you may fill out an "Architecture Program-Request for Course Waiver" form available in the front office.
