


Q2 - What is your program of study? (select all that apply)


Q3 - Are you a part-time or full-time student?


Q4 - Are you the first person in your immediate family to attend college?


Q5 - What is your gender identity? (select all that apply)


Q6 - What is your sexual orientation? (select all that apply)




Q8 - How comfortable do you feel being yourself within the CAP community?


Q9 - How connected do you feel to others in this community?


Q10 - How often do you participate in CAP activities or events outside of the classroom?


Q11 - Do you believe CAP is inclusive and welcoming of people from all backgrounds?


Q12 - When you share your ideas and opinions, do you feel that your voice is heard and respected?

Q13 - Have you ever felt excluded in any of the following settings? If so, how much?








