THE PROBLEM

The ArtLine has seen great success since its launch in 2018. However, the City of Lakewood needs more feedback in the form of qualitative data and trail user feedback. The city hopes to improve pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure and connectivity to community amenities by activating corridors along the ArtLine, and wishes to better understand how the ArtLine can be maintained and funded in the short and long-term.
