



Procedure Title: **Teaching Assistant Pay Structure in the College of Architecture and Planning**

I. Pay Structure

Effective with the Spring 2022 semester all students will be paid as follows:

1. **GPTIs** will be paid at the current lecturer rate set by the College. They will be paid \$5,400/semester for a three-credit course and \$8,000/semester for a six-credit course.
2. **Graders**
 - a. All graders at the undergraduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$16 per hour.
 - b. All graders at the graduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$18 per hour.
 - c. All graders at the PhD level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$20 per hour.
3. **Teaching Assistants**
 - a. All teaching assistants at the undergraduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$17 per hour.
 - b. All teaching assistants at the graduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$19 per hour.
 - c. All teaching assistants at the PhD level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$21 per hour.

Students who held teaching assistantships prior to Fall 2019 will be grandfathered in to the previous rates set by the College.
