

Procedure Title: Teaching Assistant Pay Structure in the College of Architecture and Planning

I. Pay Structure

Effective with the Spring 2024 semester all students will be paid as follows:

1. **GPTIs** will be paid at the current lecturer rate set by the College. They will be paid \$5,454/semester for a three-credit course and \$8,080/semester for a six-credit course.

2. Graders

- a. All graders at the undergraduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$18.29 per hour.
- b. All graders at the graduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$18.75 per hour.
- c. All graders at the PhD level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$20 per hour.

3. Teaching Assistants

- a. All teaching assistants at the undergraduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$18.50 per hour.
- b. All teaching assistants at the graduate level will be paid hourly at a rate of \$19 per hour.
- c. All teaching assistants at the PhD level will paid hourly at a rate of \$21 per hour.

4. Exception Rates

- a. ARCH 2111, Design Studio I Under Working Title: Instructing Teaching Assistant
 - i. Contract rate of \$5,670 for semester. Based off PhD level of \$21/hour at 15 hours per week over 18-weeks (16-week semester plus one before and after).

Students who held teaching assistantships prior to Fall 2019 will be grandfathered in to the previous rates set by the College.
