

Buena Vista experiences substantial seasonal population shifts.









Parks

The existing park system consists of 20 unique community, neighborhood, pocket, and special use parks. The Recreation Department's vision is "to serve the local community by facilitating affordable and inclusive recreation opportunities." Similarly, the Comprehensive Plan wishes to provide high-quality community services including well-maintained parks, create a clean and safe community with a defined sense of place, and encourage stewardship and sustainable practices.

Goal: Ensuring that all residents are within a 10-minute walk from a park




Goal: Provide regular maintenance and upkeep of parks facilities

Trails

Trails provides safe, non-motorized connectivity within communities. Trails can serve as functional transit routes or recreational pathways. Within the municipal boundaries of Buena Vista there are 13 miles of dedicated trails including bike lanes and sharrows. With seven miles, half of the town trails are paved and the remaining six miles are natural paths. The 3-Mile Plan area includes an additional 19 miles of trails.
