
Chasing the American Dream: How Everyday Travel Plays a Role in Immigrants' Integration into Society

- Funding: CAP Start-up Fund (Dates active: 2018-2020)
- Keywords: immigrants; integration; shared modes; trip purpose
- Findings:
 - Immigrants make fewer social, recreation, or errand trips than US-born individuals
 - Immigrants make more exercise trips than US-born counterparts
 - Living in a denser location linked to more social, recreation, or exercise trips
 - Driver status and more education linked to more trips for all purposes except education
 - Those from larger households make fewer trips across all purposes except education
